ABOUT THE FOUNDATION



INVESTING IN THE ADVANCEMENT OF EXCELLENCE

The Mequon-Thiensville Education Foundation was incorporated in 1998 as a non-profit organization committed to advancing educational excellence. The Foundation is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors, which operates independently yet in conjunction with the Mequon-Thiensville School District and Board of Education. The Foundation is a tax-exempt charitable organization under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue code. The MTEF benefits all six schools in the MTSD, consisting of Donges Bay Elementary School, Oriole Lane Elementary School, Wilson Elementary School, Lake Shore Middle School, Steffen Middle School, and Homestead High School.



The Mission of the MTEF is to develop community-wide private financial support for the Mequon-Thiensville School District and, through grants, to help support continued excellence in education.

- To achieve a distinct, beneficial, and clearly understood role in the community.
- To collaborate with school district personnel and other school support groups to identify ways to maintain the educational excellence our children deserve.
- To seek and support creative ways to ensure the school district advances in technology, curriculum and personnel.
- To expand our parent, staff, and community donor base.

MTEF SUCCESS STORY



The MTEF was excited to contribute to the new K-8 science curriculum that rolled out during the 2017-18 school year. Thanks to generous donations and a successful Fund-A-Grant campaign specifically raising funds for science and technology, MTEF was able to grant the MTSD funds to update their K-8 science courses, purchase computers for student learning, and provide personnel training related to the new curriculum.

Middle school students quickly adjusted to the new curriculum and enjoy what the new curriculum, STEMscopes, adds to their science classes. Lauren, a Lake Shore 7th grader, commented that "each unit has something for all types of learners. I like that there are articles, videos and hands-on experiments for each lesson so that we can really learn a lot about each topic."

Allison Rudich, Lake Shore Principal, shared that "STEMcopes engages students differently and prepares them for how they will be learning as they get older." She enjoyed the variety of science topics that students were challenged with throughout the year and felt that students really enjoyed the labs that went along with each lesson.

Teachers love the blending of technology with hands-on activities and feel that they can dive deeper into various topics than allowed by previous curricula. Middle school teachers shared the following comments about the new science curriculum:

[&]quot;The new curriculum is much more rigorous and engaging for the students"

[&]quot;Students have had much more in depth experiences"

[&]quot;The curriculum challenges them to think differently than they have in the past," and

[&]quot;The blending of technology with the hands-on learning has provided more real life experiences"

EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARDS



It is important to recognize the major impact that strong teachers have on students. The annual MTEF Excellence in Teaching awards are given to educators who demonstrate exemplary leadership in the preparation of students for continued academic advancement at the elementary, middle, and high school levels. All recipients must demonstrate good communication and leadership skills; exhibit a willingness to become involved; share their teaching expertise with students, as well as peers; incorporate innovative teaching methods; and have a positive impact on students.

MS WORLD LANGUAGE LAB (\$25,000)

To be able to offer a variety of World Language options regardless of enrollment, Lake Shore and Steffen Middle Schools are offering students a blended-learning opportunity. This grant will help fund Chromebooks and FuelEd online World Language curriculum for each World Language Lab.

HS SPANISH & FRENCH CURRICULUM RESOURCES (\$35,000)

New textbooks will be a reliable and enriching resource for French 2 and Spanish 3 students. French 1 and Spanish 2 textbooks were replaced last year—this next level of textbooks will ensure a consistent experience and system of support for students.

BIOLOGY CURRICULUM RESOURCES (\$8,000)*

This grant will enhance MTSD biology students' engagement with the latest research, learning tools and teaching strategies. This year all 9th grade students will take Biology.

AP COMPUTER SCIENCE RESOURCES (\$4,500)

The iPad Pros provided in this grant will help equip students with essential computing skills and provide multidisciplinary opportunities.

DIGITAL ART CURRICULUM RESOURCES (\$1,800)

With this grant of a Pen Display Tablet, Digital Art 2 students will be able to sketch, paint and draw directly on screen and replicate the natural effects of pencils, pens and brushes digitally.

*The \$8,000 Biology grant replaces the 2017-2018 \$7,800 Chemistry grant unused by MTSD. The \$66,500 total Curriculum amount takes into account that \$7,800 was already accounted for in last year's annual report.

TECHNOLOGY \$124,451

PERSONALIZED DIGITAL LEARNING RESOURCES – CHROMEBOOKS (\$95,480)

As curriculum shifts to more online interaction and requires more web-based resources, devices at all buildings are in high demand. A set of Chromebooks for each building will help grow the number of available devices.

STEM LAPTOPS (\$18,971)

Laptops for HHS's new STEM Lab will allow PLTW and STEM students the ability to use technology throughout the room as they work on hands-on projects.

EXPEDITION KITS (\$10,000)

This set of virtual reality teaching tools (to travel between the three elementary schools) includes everything needed to take students on virtual field trips without leaving the classroom. Students can explore historical sites, breathtaking images, outer space, college campuses and much more.

GRANT AWARDS AND ENDOWMENT FUND



PERSONNEL \$47,500

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (\$32,500)

The MTEF appreciates one of MTSD's greatest resources: outstanding teachers. To help educators continue to grow and keep up with best practices, the MTEF will be granting all six school principals discretionary support to cover staff professional development.

HHS WRITING LAB (\$15,000)

Before and after school, and during every hour of the instructional day, High School English teachers will continue to help students with an array of writing assignments—from outlines to research reports, with the support of this grant.

DONOR-DESIGNATED DONATIONS

\$10,515

Individual donors have directed and funded grants to meet specific needs throughout the school district. One example is this year's Leave a Legacy project which helped equip the high school with the hardware, wiring and software needed to install multiple industrial-quality LCD video screens in high-traffic areas.


EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARDS

ENDOWMENT FUND

Established in 2002, the Mequon-Thiensville Education Foundation's Endowment Fund was created with the goal of eventually providing an ongoing source of income for operating expenses and general funding purposes. The Fund was seeded with private donations, and continues to grow through private contributions and investment growth. The goal is to grow the Endowment Fund to \$1 million, after which the Foundation will use earnings to support overall program objectives. The Fund is currently managed by the Greater Milwaukee Foundation.

FUNDRAISERS
