

ES PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT (\$35,000)

Supporting MTSD's youngest learners, this grant purchases much-needed developmentally appropriate and supplementary playground equipment. This grant wraps up our commitment to providing all three elementary schools with new outdoor 4K & 5K exploratory equipment.

MS SCIENCE EQUIPMENT (\$9,000)

This grant funds the purchase of 28 chemistry scales to be used in middle school science classes. All students in middle school take science and will benefit from the use of these high-quality scales when conducting experiments. 14 scales will be supplied to both Lake Shore and Steffen during the first Trimester of 2022-23.

HHS HUMAN BODY SYSTEMS (\$50,000)

Interest in the Anatomy and Physiology course has grown significantly over the past few years with our high school students. This grant provides funds to purchase equipment such as skeleton models and clay for the new PLTW - Human Body Systems class. This important grant will support approximately 40% of all Homestead students with an enhanced curriculum and hands-on learning opportunities in science.

HHS AEROSPACE ENGINEERING (\$3,400)

This grant provides the necessary materials for the new PLTW - Aerospace Engineering class. The equipment funded consists of various model kits and sensors students will use throughout this course.

PERSONNEL \$19,000

HHS WRITING LAB (\$15,000)

Homestead High School English teachers continue to help students with an array of writing assignments—from outlines and research reports to college essays—our students are becoming stronger writers with the support of this grant.

EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARDS (\$4,000)

Educators who demonstrate exemplary leadership in the preparation of students for continued academic advancement at the elementary, middle and high school levels as well as a district specialist are awarded with this grant.

TECHNOLOGY \$5,900

MS SOCIAL STUDIES TECHNOLOGY (\$5,900)

In an effort to supplement a previous MTEF grant for Google Expedition Kits, this grant will enable the MTSD to purchase RobotLab VR Expedition apps to replace unsupported technology and make the Google Expedition goggles operational. Our middle school students will benefit from this grant with the ability to embark on virtual field trips to places such as Egypt to support their learning during social studies units.


DONOR-DESIGNATED DONATIONS

ENDOWMENT FUND

Established in 2002, the Mequon-Thiensville Education Foundation's Endowment Fund was created with the goal of eventually providing an ongoing source of income for operating expenses and general funding purposes. The Fund was seeded with private donations and continues to grow through private contributions and investment growth. The goal was to grow the Endowment Fund to \$1 million, after which the Foundation may use earnings to support overall program objectives. Once the \$1 million fiscal year-end Endowment Fund balance was achieved, the MTEF board may withdraw up to 4% annually of the year-end fiscal balance. These distributions can continue so long as the fiscal year-end balance is at or above \$750,000. At fiscal year-end 2021 the Fund reached \$1 million. In an effort to fully fund designated grants for 2022-2023 the Foundation will use proceeds from the Fund to overcome a significant shortfall in private donations.

FUNDRAISERS


