INVESTING IN THE ADVANCEMENT OF EXCELLENCE

The Mequon-Thiensville Education Foundation was incorporated in 1998 as a non-profit organization committed to advancing educational excellence. The Foundation is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors, which operates independently yet in conjunction with the Mequon-Thiensville School District and Board of Education. The Foundation is a tax-exempt charitable organization under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue code. The MTEF benefits all six schools in the MTSD, consisting of Donges Bay Elementary School, Oriole Lane Elementary School, Wilson Elementary School, Lake Shore Middle School, Steffen Middle School, and Homestead High School.



The Mission of the MTEF is to develop community-wide private financial support for the Mequon-Thiensville School District and, through grants, to help support continued excellence in education.

- To collaborate with school district personnel and other school support groups to identify ways to maintain the educational excellence our children deserve.
- To seek and support creative ways to ensure the school district advances in technology, curriculum and personnel.

The MTEF granted new tech devices for all MTSD schools amidst the COVID-19 outbreak to help ensure that every student and teacher would have access to technology, no matter what the school year looked like. The MTEF began reviewing grant requests in February; however, when COVID-19 hit, their original plan was altered to accommodate anticipated technological needs. These tech devices provide students with the flexibility to work from home or school, which is important as schools have needed to transition between the two options. The MTEF also granted audiovisual devices for teachers, who are turning to new technology to communicate and interact with their students. Since it's inception in 1998, the Foundation has granted over \$4.6 million to MTSD.

Students from third all the way to 12th grade are reaping the benefits of these grants, as each student is ensured to have access to a school laptop as part of the MTSD 1:1 Chromebook initiative. AnaMaria, a fifth grader at Wilson Elementary School, uses her Chromebook daily, regardless of whether she is on campus or distance learning. It is "easy to use and sometimes works like an iPad if you have one with a touchscreen. It is small, so I can easily bring it to school and it helps me focus," she said.

At middle and high schools, students are using their devices daily as well. Ben, a seventh grader at Lake Shore Middle School, says he likes "how we are able to use our individual computers at school and then bring our computers home and use them for homework." Paige, a senior at Homestead High School, reports that her Chromebook has "helped me a lot with online learning. I thought it was going to be a struggle to connect

with my teachers and understand the material but it's been fairly easy to communicate."

As for teachers, they too have appreciated how technology has helped them adapt to the new learning landscape. Devika Werth, a seventh-grade teacher at Lake Shore Middle School, explained how helpful her devices are. "Due to COVID social distancing procedures this year, my classroom was moved to the Science Lab because it is a bigger space." Ms. Werth uses two Mobile Presentation Stations, which are large smartboards on wheels that were previously donated by MTEF. She is able to broadcast both virtual learners via Zoom and lessons at once with the two screens. And instead of having students change rooms, this technology allows students to safely stay put yet mix it up via a live-stream lesson from a teacher in another room. "With the help of MTEF, I am able to teach all my students at once and keep students engaged with the lessons," she said.

Steve Manor, a math teacher at Homestead High School, synopsized the importance of tech this year. "I don't really know how I would teach a blended learning class effectively without technology--my brain would have to multitask at a rate that I couldn't keep up with."

EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARDS



It is important to recognize the major impact that strong teachers have on students. The annual MTEF Excellence in Teaching awards are given to educators who demonstrate exemplary leadership in the preparation of students for continued academic advancement at the elementary, middle, and high school levels. In 2019-2020, an extra award was given to recognize a district specialist as well.

All recipients must demonstrate good communication and leadership skills; exhibit a willingness to become involved; share their teaching expertise with students, as well as peers; incorporate innovative teaching methods; and have a positive impact on students.

Educators were surprised during end-of-school events and at their homes - socially distancing in the sunshine.

ES, MS & HS TECH DEVICES (\$109,286)*

Like no other past year, tech devices are needed! The majority of this year's grants provided Chromebooks for students at all six schools.

AUDIOVISUAL RECORDING DEVICES (\$30,000)

As students are more engaged when they can see and hear their teacher, this grant helped provide teachers with audiovisual equipment used to create more dynamic video lessons.

PERSONNEL

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (\$32,500)

The MTEF appreciates one of MTSD's greatest resources: outstanding teachers. To help educators continue to grow and keep up with best practices, the MTEF granted all six school principals discretionary support to cover staff professional development.

HHS WRITING LAB (\$15,000)

Whether on campus or remotely, High School English teachers continue to help students with an array of writing assignments—from outlines to research reports, with the support of this grant. Thank you to the Sydney Lauren Tabakin Memorial Fund.

CURRICULUM

CANVAS LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (\$30,000)**

This grant allows students to access their classroom resources and engage in collaborative discussions via one central and protected location.

The **Canvas Learning Management System grant includes \$1,193 in funds from the 2019-2020 ES Playground grant not spent. The \$28,807 total takes into account that \$1,193 was already accounted for in last year's annual report.

This grant supports initiatives that promote student belonging and inclusion with a focus on race relations and fostering a bias-free culture.


EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARDS

The goal is to grow the Endowment Fund to \$1 million, after which the Foundation will use earnings to support overall program objectives. The Fund is currently managed by the Greater Milwaukee Foundation.


