ABOUT THE FOUNDATION



INVESTING IN THE ADVANCEMENT OF EXCELLENCE

The Mequon-Thiensville Education Foundation was incorporated in 1998 as a non-profit organization committed to advancing educational excellence. The Foundation is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors, which operates independently yet in conjunction with the Mequon-Thiensville School District and Board of Education. The Foundation is a tax-exempt charitable organization under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue code. The MTEF benefits all six schools in the MTSD, consisting of Donges Bay Elementary School, Oriole Lane Elementary School, Wilson Elementary School, Lake Shore Middle School, Steffen Middle School, and Homestead High School.



The Mission of the MTEF is to develop community-wide private financial support for the Mequon-Thiensville School District and, through grants, to help support continued excellence in education.

GOALS

- To achieve a distinct, beneficial, and clearly understood role in the community.
- To collaborate with school district personnel and other school support groups to identify ways to maintain the educational excellence our children deserve.
- To seek and support creative ways to ensure the school district advances in technology, curriculum, and personnel.
- To expand our parent, staff, and community donor base.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The Foundation is committed to helping address the budgetary shortfalls and to ensuring that the Mequon-Thiensville School District advances in technology, curriculum, and personnel. Declining enrollments coupled with the unfavorable state funding formula make this a fiscally challenging time for the Mequon-Thiensville School District. Creation of strong private-public partnerships empowers supporters of public education to partner to make a difference as we prepare our students for the 21st century global world.















MTEF SUCCESS STORY



The MTSD's 4K Program kicked off its inaugural year in 2015-2016, and the MTEF was proud to be a part by providing grant assistance. Funds were used toward math manipulatives, emotional learning resources, technology, and classroom libraries.

Hilary James, 4K program chairperson and teacher at Wilson Elementary, shares her insight of how the MTEF's support impacted students: "In building our classroom libraries, we were able to choose a wide variety of author studies that we are using as a springboard for our units incorporating emergent reading and writing skills. Across the district, students were wild about the author Mo Willems and his use of speech bubbles! This spilled over into our students' writing, which was shared with peers and parents. In addition, we purchased several small readers where children were able to retell stories and become immersed in books that captivated their attention. The use of technology in the 4K classrooms aided the teachers in differentiating instruction, helping to meet the needs of all learners. Several programs were used (such as the app Handwriting Without Tears) to reinforce the concepts and skills taught throughout our day. The use of the iPads was a great way to infuse technology appropriately for our youngest of learners."

MTSD 4K parent Kristin Smith said she was actually "surprised and happy" to see iPads in the classroom. "I was very impressed at how the teachers incorporated the iPads into the classroom to help with learning. My daughter benefited from the exposure to the technology, but still loved and engaged in traditional learning methods. Technology is the world we live in today."

Ms. James also commented: "Without a doubt, we would not have had such an amazing first year without the support of MTSD and the grant money from MTEF. Because of the resources made available by the MTEF, the teachers were able to engage all learners with a variety of materials, to meet each child where they were at and move them forward on the learning continuum, setting the stage for future success."

EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARDS



It is important to recognize the major impact that strong teachers have on students. The annual MTEF Excellence in Teaching awards are given to educators who demonstrate exemplary leadership in the preparation of students for continued academic advancement at the elementary, middle, and high school levels. In 2015-2016, an extra award was given to recognize a district specialist as well.

All recipients must demonstrate good communication and leadership skills; exhibit a willingness to become involved; share their teaching expertise with students, as well as peers; incorporate innovating teaching methods; and have a positive impact on students.

GRANT AWARDS FOR 2016-2017

TECHNOLOGY



CHROMEBOOKS (\$25,540)

As our students continue to utilize more online academic resources, ever useful and always needed Chromebooks will be purchased for the elementary and middle schools.

4K iPADS (\$18,000)

The MTEF is excited to continue to support our 4K learners. Rounding out last year's grants for 4K curriculum and technology, this grant will provide additional iPads. Now all 4K students will have access to the technology, increasing student engagement and interaction in the learning process.

SCIENCE TECHNOLOGY (\$15,000)

New Windows-based laptops will utilize the latest software and provide Physics students with authentic scenarios and access to relevant data. High school Physics is taught every hour of the trimester, and this grant will help fill the great need for these computers.

\$51,500 **PERSONNEL**

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (\$32,500)

The MTEF appreciates one of MTSD's greatest resources: outstanding teachers. To help educators continue to grow and keep up with best practices, the MTEF will be granting all six school principals discretionary support to cover staff professional development.

AVID ELEMENTARY PATH TRAINING (\$19,000)

This grant will help expand the AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) program at the elementary level. The MTEF has been a financial supporter of the AVID implementation at all three school levels.

CURRICULUM \$82,000

SPRINGBOARD ELA (\$30,000)

With a goal of making rigorous courses accessible to all learners, MTSD is upgrading the 7th and 8th grade ELA (English Language Arts) curriculum to the College Board's comprehensive instructional program. The MTEF will help fund textbooks, staff development, and curriculum writing hours with this grant.

AP SEMINAR (\$16,250)

This grant will be used to cover some of the start-up costs for the new AP (Advanced Placement) English Language and Seminar class at HHS. Students will have the opportunity to hone their critical reading, writing, and thinking skills, while strengthening their abilities as researchers and communicators.

ROBOTICS I (\$15,250)

The MTEF will help fund the new high school Robotics I class start-up costs (equipment, textbooks, and curriculum writing hours). The new course will allow students to develop mechanical design and critical-thinking skills needed to construct, operate, and program robots through collaboration and project planning.

GRANT AWARDS AND ENDOWMENT FUND



HHS WRITING LAB (\$15,000)

Before and after school, and during every hour of the instructional day, high school English teachers will continue to help students with an array of writing assignments—from an outline to a research report—with the support of this grant for the Sydney Lauren Tabakin Writing Lab.

LANGUAGE HONORS CLASSES (\$5,500)

This grant will cover the start-up costs for the new Latin IV Honors and Mandarin Chinese IV Honors classes. Both courses focus on all four aspects of communication—listening, speaking, reading, and writing—to help prepare students for collegiate-level content.

DONOR-DESIGNATED DONATIONS

\$32,744

Individual donors have directed and funded grants to meet specific needs throughout the school district. The Leave a Legacy project, Room 2016, is one of many designated grants included in this total.


EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARDS

ENDOWMENT FUND

Established in 2002, the Mequon-Thiensville Education Foundation's Endowment Fund was created with the goal of eventually providing an ongoing source of income for operating expenses and general funding purposes. The Fund was seeded with private donations, and continues to grow through private contributions and investment growth. The goal is to grow the Endowment Fund to \$1 million, after which the Foundation will use earnings to support overall program objectives. The Fund is currently managed by the Greater Milwaukee Foundation.




FUNDRAISERS

THE ANNUAL GIVING CAMPAIGN direct mailing, MTEF's largest fundraiser, was sent to all Mequon-Thiensville residents in October.

The May Matching Donation Challenge was a successful new event this year. Due to the generosity of a few anonymous community members, all May donations were matched, dollar for dollar, up to \$10,000 total. The campaign exceeded the goal, as more than \$30,000 was collected.

Together, these Annual Giving appeals generated more than \$216,000 in donations.

THE TARTAN BASH is a celebration of and a fundraiser for our excellent schools. In January 2016, the Tartan Bash's "Party for Our Pupils" was held at the River Club of Mequon. HHS's Jazz Ensemble and Chamber Orchestra provided pre-dinner entertainment. Co-chairs Liz Braatz and Tina Timm, along with board member Tracy Lappin and Silent Auction Co-chairs Shana Brewer, Heidi Joynt, and Roxanne Lentz helped generate more than \$115,000 in profits, including \$51,650 through the Fund-A-Grant voice auction, which was designated for portable technology at all six schools.
